

# Claude on Windows

In this article I write myself some notes on my usage of Claude on Windows. It may contain a variety of things that are unrelated to one another.

## 1 Personal commands

The [claude documentation](#) indicates that personal commands can be set in `~/.claude`, but there is no documentation about Windows.

On Windows, the `~/.claude` directory is located in `C:\Users\<username>\.claude`, or `%USERPROFILE%\claude`.

## 2 New personal commands

New commands are not automatically added in existing sessions.  
One has to restart the session to see the new commands.
