3 Status

The state of completion of the article.

- Draft: In the process of collecting ideas.
- In progress: In the process of updating the structure of the article and its content. Most articles on this website will be in this state.
- Finished: Unlikely that the content will be touched/revised.

4 Readability

A field to help readers quickly assess whether an article is appropriate for their level of expertise and available attention.

5 Importance

How important the topic is to my eyes (the last time the importance value was set).

1. Low
2. Medium
3. High

6 Confidence

An indicator of my confidence on the topic. Confidence can also be established at the level of statements.

1. Impossible, $P(e) = 0$
2. Almost unlikely, $P(e) < 0.05$
3. Very unlikely, $P(e) < 0.25$
4. Unlikely, $P(e) < 0.5$
5. Uncertain, $P(e) == 0.5$

6. Likely, $P(e) > 0.5$
7. Very likely, $P(e) \geq 0.75$
8. Almost likely, $P(e) \geq 0.95$
9. Certain/Definite, $P(e) = 1$
